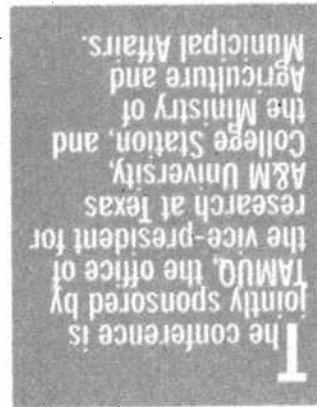


TAMUQ to organize annual mathematics conference
